Encouraging Creative Teamwork,

Goal; Participants will learn to work together as part of a team. Many components will be explored and implemented, such as personal space, physical and emotional boundaries, decision making, democratic process, accepting constructive feedback, giving constructive feedback, learning coping skills, conflict resolution/ collaborating with others and mastery of art materials. The goal is to learn group process without judgement about anyone's drawing ability. There is a role to be played by each person. This entire process may take longer than twelve weeks. It would be advantageous to have an Art Therapist run this class.

Note that this process can also be used for group murals done on mural paper. Other art mediums can be used for such purposes such as pastel, marker, crayon or art materials of groups choice.

Creative Teamwork

Objective; Participants will use the medium of art as a means of expression and communication. They will learn to work as a team to overcome challenges and collaborate in creating a piece of art. In class one they will begin to share ideas.

- 2. Guidelines of class are discussed.
- 3. Participants will share their expectations and understanding of the class.
- 4. Participants will begin to brainstorm ideas for the mural.
